ANSWER BANKS FOR

TREASURE HUNT BOOKS

Level B

A simple intervention for students who can read the treasure hunt clues, but struggle to solve them.

Suggestions: Give the student the illustrated list of possible answers for the hunt s/he is about to read. Ask if s/he is familiar with all the answers. If not, explain a few things about unfamiliar items. Instruct the student to read the first clue and then look at the list. If s/he still can't solve the clue, s/he should reread it, looking for information that narrows the possible solutions or provides the key to the answer.
